"We selected September 25th," said Mr. Lainer, "because it falls just before the Jewish High Holy Days, a time of spiritual reflection and rdedication to the principles of Judaism by Jews throughout the world."

"For many years El Al Air Lines has unsuccessfully attempted to negotiate mutual landing rights with Japan Air Lines," said Mr. Lainer, "and the excuses given by Japan Air-Lines are transparent. JAL has been so intransigent in this matter that it has even refused a proposal by Israel that El Al planes be permitted landing rights in Tokyo, with profits to be shared with JAL, while relieving JAL planes of any obligations to land in Israel."

"JAL's submission to Arab blackmail in fear of retribution for an opening of air routes between Tokyo and Tel Aviv is ironic," continued Mr. Lainer, "in light of the recent hijacking and destruction of a JAL \$25 million
