

NATL. JEWISH HOSP. HONORS GOV. MIKE O'CALLAGHAN OCT. 7

Governor Mike O'Callaghan will be presented with the first annual Honor Award by the National Jewish Hospital and Research Center, during a \$100-a-plate dinner on October 7, at the Stardust Hotel.

The dinner, sponsored by the Las Vegas Friends of the Denver hospital, will see all proceeds going to further the great work of the world-famed medical facility.

Allan D. Sachs, president of the Stardust and chairman of the dinner committee, said Governor O'Callaghan

distinguished service to our state and the nation, as well as his humanitarian interest in the National Jewish Hospital."

Specializing in chronic respiratory diseases, the hospital has long been recognized as the leader in treatment and research of such ailments as asthma, emphysema and tuberculosis.

Sachs said patients are accepted from all parts of the world, regardless of race, creed or ability to pay for treatment. The hosp-

ital is considered to be the "medical court of last resort." Patients with serious illnesses, not responding to treatment at other medical facilities, are sent to the National Jewish Hospital.

Many dignitaries from throughout the state have already accepted invitations to serve as associate chairmen of the dinner honoring the Governor, and it is anticipated that there will be important officials from all over the country flying in to honor him.
