Nearly 50 religious educators, representing six institutions of higher learning in New York and New Jersey, have issued a declaration expressing solidarity with Israel during the current conflict in the Middle East and in her continuing struggle for existence, the American Jewish Congress reported.

The largest Baptist church in the world has published a half-page ad in the Dallas Morning News urging support of Israel, it was reported by the American Jewish Congress.

"All United Jewish Appeal programs which are not directly and immediately involved in meeting our historic 1974 goal of \$750 million," stated Paul Zuckerman, UJA General Chairman, "have been postponed or cancelled. Our leaders and the leaders of Federations and Welfare Funds have given up their businesses and their daily activities to devote themselves full-time to meet the crisis."
