

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM....Doctors and medical personnel from all over the world have arrived in Israel since the outbreak of the Yom Kippur War and have joined teams working on wounded soldiers at the Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center here.

NEW YORK, The United Jewish Appeal has scheduled a series of intensive, five-day missions to Israel, starting November 18, leaving from New York each Sunday evening.

NEW YORK, N.Y.---In a joint communique to Israel's Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Education Yigal Allon, for transmission to Israeli pedagogues and pupils, the ten leading American Jewish educational organizations expressed their "shoulder to shoulder" solidarity with Israel, their unity of purpose in aiding Israel during the current crisis, and the concern and support of 600,000 American Jewish children enrolled in schools and programs sponsored by the participating organizations.

NEW YORK---Moshe Dayan, Israeli Minister of Defense, will be the keynote speaker at the December 8 Banquet of the 1974 Annual National Conference of the United Jewish Appeal, at the N. Y. Hilton.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The real estate firm of Benjamin Swig of San Francisco, Jack D. Weiler and Robert H. Arnow of New York will direct a campaign to provide a place of worship and learning for Jews whose synagogues have been targets of vandalism on Manhattan's Lower East Side.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Sen. Walter F. Mondale (D., Minn.) has suggested that if the Arabs embargo oil to the United States then the U.S. should not supply them with food. Mondale made his suggestion in Detroit at the 60th anniversary dinner of the Michigan Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The highly authoritative magazine Aviation Week and Space Technology reports that Soviet Nuclear weapons are now in Egypt, poised to strike at Tel Aviv or any other Israeli city.

PARIS (WNS) -- Police have confirmed a report that an Iraqi commando has tried to kidnap French Senate President Alain Pöher who is known for his close ties with Israel.

"WAR OF JEWS" BEGINS

OVER START OF YOM KIPPUR WAR

JERUSALEM (WNS) What has already been dubbed as "the war of the Jews" is going in Israel over recriminations on why Israel was caught by surprise by the Egyptian and Syrian attack on Yom Kippur. Premier Golda Meir intends to raise the question of an investigation at Cabinet level after her return from London, according to Deputy Premier Yigal Allon.

The army is embarking on its own "inquiry." Chief of Staff Gen. David Elazar has told the Cabinet that the inquiry would cover war preparations, the preparedness of the Army, the battles and the strategies employed.

The inquiries, it is hoped, will cool off the increasingly bitter public debate over the start of the war.

Meanwhile Attorney general Meir Shamgar is an investigating an interview with Gen. Ariel Sharon published in the New York Times in which Sharon charged that his superior officer had failed to exploit in time his thrust across the Suez Canal. Sharon, who is the founder and a leader of the Likud opposition, charged that he could have completely encircled the Third Egyptian Army before the cease-fire if his superiors had realized what was going on.

Defense Minister Moshe Dayan, told a meeting of local Labor party branches that the Soviet threat of intervention prevented Israel from obtaining a decisive victory. He added

that the war was different than the previous ones because of more sophisticated weapons in the hands of the Arabs. "Whoever thinks our planes were downed because of mistakes by General Headquarters and not by missiles is utterly mistaken," he said.
