

ISRAELI POWs MURDERED

"Kill them wherever you find them and be careful that they do not trick you, for they are a people deceivers, pretending to surrender so that they overcome and kill you. Kill them and do not show any pity or mercy."

The Israeli complaint cited specific instances of the murder of Israeli soldiers who had surrendered, of torture and humiliation of prisoners, of assaults on wounded prisoners and sexual assaults on POWs.

The complaint against Syria cited new cases of murder and brutality Israel has uncovered since filling its original complaint on November 10. Tekoah said they were committed by Syrian, Moroccan and Iraqi soldiers serving on the Syrian front.

The document cited the killing of Israeli prisoners, the murder of pilots who parachuted into Syria and physical abuse against Israeli POWs by their captors.

The document also charged that "already prior to the outbreak of the war, instructions were issued to the Syrian army troops to remove the identity discs from the bodies of dead Israeli soldiers so as to render their subsequent identification more difficult."

Meanwhile some 150 women chained themselves to the iron fence that surrounds the United Nations to protest the Syrian treatment of Israeli POWs and to demand that Syria turn over the names of POWs and MIAs to Israel. Police permitted the demonstrators to remain for two hours after which the UN security guards arrived to cut the chains. The women were led by Mrs. Max Schenk, chairman of the Executive of the American Zionist Federation, and Mrs. Sylvia Eisen, a Hadassah leader and head of the Long Island AZF.

Later in Paris, the Israeli delegation to the Amnesty International convention accused Syria and Egypt of torturing and killing Israeli POWs and asked for Red Cross inspection tours to examine the treatment given the Israeli prisoners.

NO SYRIAN TALKS UNTIL POW LIST

JERUSALEM (WNS) The Israeli government will not enter into peace negotiations with Syria until Damascus produces a list of Israeli prisoners of war it holds and allows the Red Cross to visit them in accordance with the requirements of the Geneva Convention.

The decision of the government was submitted to the Knesset by Defense Minister Moshe Dayan. The motion which was sent to a committee also stated that once Syria complied, Israel would insist that the first item on the agenda of its talks with Syria should be a POW exchange.

Dayan said that U.S. Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger, with whom he met in Washington, would raise the issue when he visits Damascus.

Meanwhile Israel's Ambassador to the U.S. Simcha Dinitz said in Tel Aviv that the U.S. will support Israel should it refuse to sit down with Syria. He said the American memory is still fresh over their own POWs in Vietnam.
