**MAIL MOVED FAST SAYS POSTMASTER LIAS**

Mail moved more rapidly and more efficiently this past Xmas than ever before, thanks to the cooperation of the public in mailing their cards and packages earlier than usual, Postmaster Lias reported.

"The Postmaster General, E. T. Klassen, has noted that despite the fuel crisis cutbacks in some airline flights, and bad weather in some parts of the country, Christmas mail flowed more smoothly than in any previous year," Postmaster Lias said.

The Postmaster gave credit for the success of the holiday mail movement to the mailers themselves.
