

PRES. KATZIR FORMING NEW GOVT.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--President Ephraim Katzir has begun the first official move toward forming a new government. He has met with representatives of the Labor Alignment and the opposition Likud and will also call in the other political factions. Meanwhile Labor continued to hold unofficial talks with its present coalition partners, the National Religious Party and the Independent Liberals, about forming a new government. Finance Minister Pinhas Sapir who is leading the negotiations is attempting to separate foreign policy from religious issues in his talks with the NRP.

Meanwhile the NRP leaders are under pressure from their more militant young members who want a broad national coalition which includes Likud and who are opposed to Israel

withdrawal from any part of the West Bank area.

ORTHODOX, NON ORTHODOX CONFLICT

TEL AVIV (WNS)-- Leaders of Reform and Conservative congregations in Israel have demanded that the government not yield to the demands of the National Religious Party and the Aguda list to amend the Law of Reform.

Prof. Ezra Spicehandler, Dean of the Hebrew Union College in Jerusalem, Rabbi Bernard Segal of the Conservative Movement in Israel, and Rabbi Richard Hirsch, executive director of the World Union of Progressive Judaism, told a press conference that the change which would disqualify persons converted abroad by Conservative and Reform rabbis from immigrating to Israel under the Law of Return would imperil the nation's unity. They said the

change would constitute an interference by the secular state into the religious affairs of Jews outside of Israel.

Meanwhile in New York, the Union of Orthodox Rabbis of the U. S. and Canada has urged the NRP not to enter the government unless the Sabbath Law is corrected and expanded and the Law Of Return is amended.

ISRAELITE ADS PAY

GEN. GUR COMMANDS SYRIAN FRONT

TEL AVIV (WNS)-- Maj. Gen. Mordechai Gur who has been the head of the Israeli military team negotiating for a disengagement agreement with Egypt, will not be returning to Geneva when the talks resume.

Instead Gur has been named commander of the Syrian front replacing Maj. Gen. Itzhak

Hoffi, who has been assigned to General Headquarters as Chief of Operations. Gur was Israel's military attache in Geneva before being sent to Geneva.

In another top level shift of command, Maj. Gen. Avraham Adan, an armored corps commander, has been put in charge of the southern front.

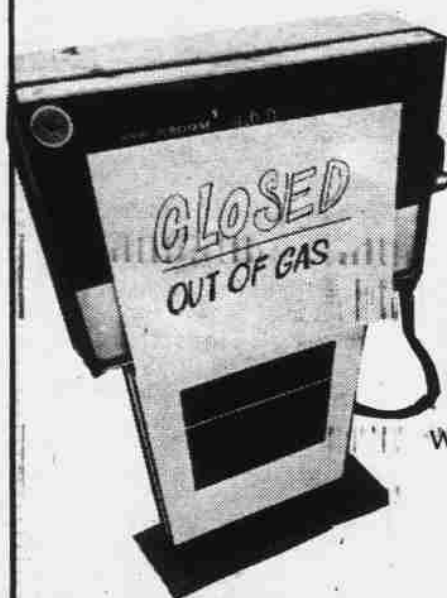
