## HIAS HELPED 4 MILLION IN 90 YEARS

The 90th anniversary of the United Hias Service was celebrated with a pledge by the organization to continue its work of helping Jews imm-igrate and resettle.

So far the organization has aided some 4 million people.

Noting that Jewish history is a history of migration, Hias pres. Carl Glick declared: "We know the future will bring thousands of refugees from countries known and yet unknown. As long as Jews have a need to move, Hias will be there to help them migrate to freedom.'

Hias was founded to aid Jews fleeing from Czarist Gaynor I. Jacobson,

executive vice-presid-ent, noted that "Ironically, as in our beginning, the largest number of assisted this year (1973) came from Europe," In Eastern In 1973 Hias resettled 3788 people 1768 Soviet including Jews and aided another 48,000.

This year it anticipates resettling 5000 Jewish refugees, the largest number since 1970, and providing help for another 50,000. The program will require a budget of \$3,368,000, and increase over \$260, 000 over 1973.

WASHINGTON (WNS) Russia and Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger met with

16 leaders of American Jewish organizations in "an off-the-record" discussion.

The meeting was a followup to one held in December and it was announced that similar meetings will be held in the future. The only comment from the participants was in the form of a short statement drafted by three of the participants, Rabbi Israel Miller, chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations; Max Fisher, chairman of the Board of Governors of the Jewish Agency and Leonard Garment, assistant to President Nixon.


