JEFF COREY is truly fantastic as Polonius, making him very human and warm and AVERY SCHREIBER, LEON CHARLES, JAMES CROMWELL & ART BURNS all make heavy contributions to the plus side of "Hamlet."
I admire EDWARD ALBERT, who is considered a star in the movies, for taking on such a small role (Fortinbras) to get stage experience. KITTY WINN (Ophelia), although she looked and acted beautifully when she went mad, unfortunately looked and acted pretty much the same when she wasn't. GEORG STANFORD BROWN is totally wrong. A... his acting and B., I can't understand casting a black actor in a role that has a line like "you look pale, Horatio delivered to him. It nearly broke up the audience and it was a little hard to take the production seriously from that point. I feel that mixed casting certainly works in some cases but would you believe a play about a family of slaves in

the South and one of them happens to be white???
