

DAYAN MAY NOT COME TO WASH. D.C.

JERUSALEM (WNS)—Defense Minister Moshe Dayan has been hinting that he may not come to Washington March 29 to meet with Sec'y of State Henry A. Kissinger on the problem of Israeli-Syrian disengagement of forces.

This despite the fact that Foreign Minister Abba Eban announced the date of Dayan's arrival after meeting with Kissinger in Wash. (Eban had to leave Washington hurriedly for London when his mother Alida Sacks Solomon-Eban died at the age of 80). Dayan's hesitation is seen here as concern by him that he may be pressured by Kissinger to make unacceptable concessions to Syria.

The Secretary of State has reportedly said that Israel should return a slice of the Golan Heights captured in the

1967 Six-Day War, possibly including the town of Kuneitra. Kissinger has said that Kuneitra is for Syria what the Suez Canal was for Egypt.

The Israeli government is solidly opposed to any pullback from the 1967 lines.

Mean while, there have been daily exchanges of fire on the Syrian-Israeli border. Three Israeli soldiers were killed during the week and two United Nations observers wounded.

In Washington, Kissinger told a news conference that the U.S. does not consider the Soviet Union responsible for the incidents on the Golan Heights. He noted that before every agreement there had been an upsurge in shooting.

At the United Nations Israeli Ambassador Yo-

sef Tekoah accused Syria of a "premeditated policy" of aggression evidenced by the "continuation and intensification of Syrian" artillery attacks.

OIL EMBARGO THREAT NO AFFECT TO ISRAEL

NEW YORK (WNS)—Israel's long-term interests and policies will not be affected by Arab oil policies, Israel Foreign Minister Abba Eban told newsmen here.

Talking to reporters after a breakfast meeting with United Nations Sec'y General Kurt Waldheim, Eban said Israel will follow its own needs regardless of any timetable set by the Arabs for lifting or reimposing oil embargoes. Eban also said the Soviet Union's role as a mediator in the Middle East crisis was limited because the USSR has no diplomatic relations and has taken a one-sided view in the dispute.

He said if the USSR wants to change its role "the cure is obvious."

LITVINOVS FAMILY COMING TO U.S.

NEW YORK (WNS)—Pavel Litvinov, the 33-year-old Soviet Jewish dissident, has left the Soviet Union and will

be immigrating to the U.S. with his wife, Maya, and their two children. Litvinov, a chemical research engineer, arrived in Vienna from Moscow and then made an application to United Hias Service there and the organization agreed to sponsor his immigration according to a Hias spokesman here.

Litvinov is the grand son of Maxim Litvinov, Soviet Foreign Minister in the 1930's and later a Soviet Ambassador in the United States.
