A library endowment fund in memory of eight-year-old Andrea Romero of Las Vegas has surpassed \$2,000, reports Harold Erickson, director of libraries at the University of Nev., Las Vegas (UNLV).

Andrea, who died last November after a short illness, was the daughter of John Romero, executive director of advertising, promotion and publicity at the Sahara Hotel, and Mrs. Denese Horlyck of Las Vegas.

Interest from the fund Erickson said, will be used each year to purchase children's books, utilized by UNLV students learning to become elementary school teachers.

"Andrea loved books and liked to read," Mrs. Horlyck said. "Her favorite character was 'Pippi Longstocking' and she appreciated so much the story of Helen Keller."

Her father, a Sahara Hotel executive, commented: "Andrea would

be pleased to know she touched so many people so deeply, and I am deeply moved at this lasting tribute to her memory. Her mother and I are very grateful to all those who contributed to the library fund."
