The Nevada State Fire Marshal's office will be conducting seminars throughout the State of Nevada, on April 8 at 10:00 A.M. scheduled for the Las Vegas Convention Center, Room 4.

Gov. Mike O'Callaghan asked for submission of ideas on how the State of Nevada can best comply with the terms of the will of the late Leo Heil in aiding wild horses.

Leo Heil, 69, a California who died in Switzerland in 1972, left approximately \$500,000 "to the State of Nevada for the preservation of wild horses in Nevada."

The typical Nevadan is disenchanted with President Nixon, concerned about inflation and opposed to foreign aid, according to the results of Congressman David Towell's 1974 "People-to-People" questionnaire.

On April 15 a group of Las Vegans will be leaving for a 10-day fact-finding mission to Israel sponsored by the Las Vegas Combined Jewish Appeal and coordinated with the government of Israel. The flight will be from Las Vegas to New York and then on to Tel Aviv, returning to Las Vegas 10 days later. The total cost of this trip is only \$1,081.00 (a similar commercial tour would cost approximately \$4,000).
