Jews this year will mark the Passover holiday in both of its contexts - as a Festival of Freedom and as a Festival of Renewal. As American Jews, we give thanks for the freedom and opportunity we enjoy in this land. We are also profoundly grateful that Israel continues to serve as a haven for Jews from many lands. We are thankful for the first steps that have been taken toward peace in the Middle East and we pray that current negotiations will lead to a just and lasting settlement there. We pray too for the quick repatriation of Israeli prisoners of war in keeping with the pattern established between Israel and Egypt, so that these men may soon be reunited with their loved ones.

To the 3,000,000 Jews in the Soviet Union, we extend a fervent wish that they may soon be able to celebrate Passover in freedom and in dignity. We extend to the thousands of Jews there who have been refused exit visas and have been subjected to merciless harassment, as well as to those who languish in labor camps, guilty of no crime except that of wanting to live as Jews with their families and friends in Israel and elsewhere. We hope for the speedy deliverance of the 4,500 Jews in Syria, the remnant of a once flourishing community, constantly subjected to discrimination and degradation and forbidden to emigrate. As a Festival of Renewal, Passover will be marked this year by Jews with a rededication to our heritage, to our responsibility for the welfare of the Jewish community, and to Israel's survival in peace and security. In the tradition of our faith, we will renew our devotion to the cause of human freedom and to the furtherance of understanding among all men. As we retell the ancient story of the molding of the Israelite slaves into a nation of free men, let us take courage from their example. Let us go forth to challenge those who would oppress, who would persecute, who would delay man's quest for peace, justice and freedom.
