Debbie Reynolds, America's sweetheart and the Desert Inn's "Million Dollar Baby" returned to the Crystal Room stage that she left 14 months ago to star in her first Broadway show, the smash musical hit "Irene"

Debbie Reynolds' success in the Broadway musical "Irene" established her as important a star on the New York stage as she is and has been in motion pictures, on television and in personal appearances.
