After an almost fatal accident, Nettie Feinstein is looking just wonderful and recuperating slowly. She should be going back to her position shortly. Lucky girl.

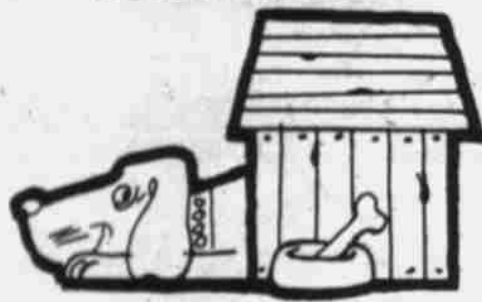
