## MRS. MEIR: 'MASSACRE MURDER FOR MURDER'S SAKE


JERUSALEM (WNS) -Premier Golda Meir called the carnage at Kiryat Shemona "Murdone it out of mere desire to murder and not for any lofty ideas of liberation.

She told the Knesset that the terrorist act was a "plain and cal-culated murder innocent children, wom-en, men and soldiers," She promised protection for the town of Kiryat Shemona.

Mrs. Meir warned Lebanon that Israel holds her responsible for the act. After she concluded her statement the Knesset rose for a moment of silence for the victims.


