

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Leon Dulzin, who has been acting chairman of both the Jewish Agency and the World Zionist Organization Executive since the death of Louis Pincus last year, has officially announced he is a candidate for both posts. A new chairman will be selected by secret ballot by the 296 members of the Jewish Agency General Assembly when it meets in Jerusalem in June.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Defense Department spokesman Jerry Friedheim told newsmen that Israel has been receiving a "continuous flow" of weapons from the U. S. during the fighting on the Golan Heights.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The United States must refrain "from exerting pressures which can lead to Israel's piecemeal dismemberment," Prof. Hans J. Morgenthau has warned in an open letter to Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger. Morgenthau, a consistent critic of efforts at detente, sent the letter as chairman of the National Committee on American Foreign Policy.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Elizabeth Holtzman (D. NY) has charged before a House immigration subcommittee that the U.S. Immigration Service has neglected to move against at least 38 alleged Nazi war criminals who live in the United States.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith and Women's American ORT have been admitted as members of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations bringing the total number of groups up to 33.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Arabs must learn that war is obsolete as a method, Israeli Ambassador Simcha Dinitz told 1500 persons attending the 46th annual Third Seder of the Greater New York Histadrut Council.

LOS ANGELES--(Special)--Leading spokesmen for America's three mainstream religions will jointly probe the future of "institutionalized" Judaism, Catholicism and Protestantism at a unique three-day colloquium Sunday through Tuesday, Apr. 21-23, on the University of Judaism's Max and Pauline Zimmer Conference Grounds in Ojai, Calif.

LAWRENCE, N.Y.--A nation-wide campaign is under way among U. S. Synagogues and Temples to secure donations of Torah Scrolls and Torah ornaments for presentation to Synagogues and Military Installations in Israel. Rabbis and Congregational leaders are urged to communicate with Rabbi Dobin at the U.S. headquarters of the American Committee, 124 Richmond Place, Lawrence, New York 11559.

NEW YORK: Great Britain's two Chief Rabbis participated in a special ceremony at Israel's Bar-Ilan University, inaugurating two new chairs of study in their honor. The Chairs are: one in Jewish Law, in the name of Immanuel Jakobovits, Chief Rabbi of the British Commonwealth; and another in Sephardi Studies, in honor of Solomon Gaon, Haham of the Sephardi Congregations of the British Commonwealth.

MRS. MEIR: 'MASSACRE MURDER FOR MURDER'S SAKE'

JERUSALEM (WNS) - Premier Golda Meir called the carnage at Kiryat Shemona "Murder for the sake of murder" and said; "The people who committed this latest crimes have done it out of mere desire to murder and not for any lofty ideas of liberation."

She told the Knesset that the terrorist act was a "plain and calculated murder of innocent children, women, men and soldiers." She promised protection for the town of Kiryat Shemona.

Mrs. Meir warned Lebanon that Israel holds her responsible for the act. After she concluded her statement the Knesset rose for a moment of silence for the victims.

Later Foreign Minister Abba Eban in a statement denouncing the massacre said "The lesson must be an

implacable resistance to the terrorists and an end to deplorable indulgence with which these organizations have been surrounded in many places."

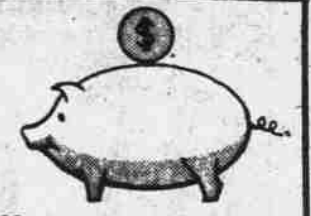
