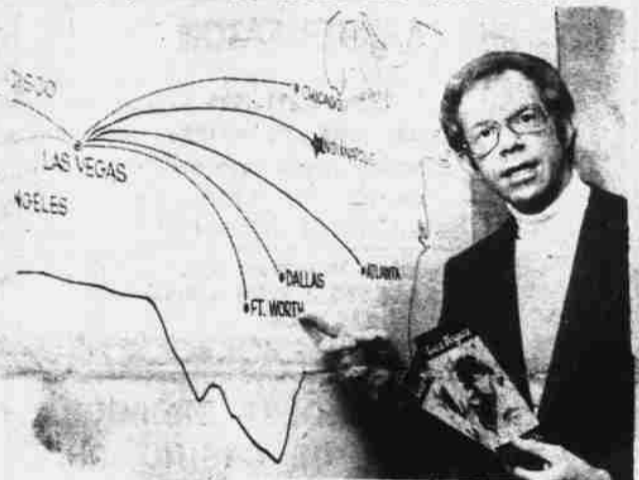

A definite need for fresh, new faces on the L. TEL AVIV (WNS) -- The Labor Party has selected Labor Minister Ytzhak Rabin, the former Chief of Staff and Ambassador to Washington, as its new leader and Israel's next Prime Minister should he succeed in forming a new government.

Rabin was selected over Information Minister Shimon Peres by the Labor Party's 600 member Central Committee by a narrow margin of 298-254.

Rabin, noting that it was difficult following Golda Meir, who was a symbol of Israel's founding generation, said it was now time for the sons of the founders to take over. The Jerusalem-born Rabin, if he is successful in forming a coalition, would be the youngest and first native-born Israeli to become prime minister.

Rabin is expected to take charge personally of the tough coalition talks needed to form a new government. He will have 21 days from the time that President Ephraim Ktzir officially assigns him the mandate to form the government. He could have an extension but he said if he is unable to form a Labor-led coalition with the National Religious Party and the Independent Liberal Party, he will call for new elections.

But Rabin, a dove, will first have to heal the split within his own Labor Alignment. Many people see the big winner as Peres who finished surprisingly strong. Peres a hawk and a member of Defense Minister Moshe Dayan's Rafi faction now moves out of the shadow of Dayan. Rabin in turn was closely linked with Deputy Minister Pinhas Sapir who refused the premiership. Foreign Minister Abba Eban, who opposed Rabin, is not expected

Star-Studded Vegas

May is here, which means its the time of year when we inform our large segment of out-of-town readers of the entertainment wonders to be found in the most wonderful city in the world.

Starting at the beginning of the Strip, there's the Hacienda with a spicy, fast-paced skating show, ideal for warm weather (it is 89 degrees here), aptly titled "Spice on Ice" in the Azure Room.

A half mile north we come to the Tropicana where the extravaganza "Folies Bergere '74" starring Audrey Arno is in the showroom, while Ralph Pollak Trio entertains in the Casino lounge.

Three quarters of a mile further we come to the Alladdin where "This is Burlesque '74" is in the Bagdad Theatre while Happy Jesters is in the Sinbad Lounge.

Diagonally across the Strip is the Dunes where another extravaganza "Casino De Paris '74" is in the showroom, Russ Morgan Orchestra is upstairs in the Top of the Strip, Arturo Romero and his vilins is in the Sultan's Table and Kippy Lou in the Dome of the Sea.

Back to the East side of the Strip we find M. G. M. Grand where the extravaganza "Hallelujah Holiday" just opened in the Ziegfeld Room, while Sergio Franchi and Pat Cooper are in the Celebrity Room and Jackie Gayle and Marilyn Mave are in the Lion's Den.

Across Flamingo Road, quite naturally is the Flamingo with Marty Allen and Dyanne Whitman in the Flamingo Room while the Mills Brothers, Johnny Tillotson and Kim Brothers are in the Casino Lounge.

Cross over the Strip there's Caesars Palace with Alan King and Sally Struthers in Circus Maximus and Pupi Campo with Don Cherry are on Cleopatra's Barge.

On up the Strip, there's the Sands with Bob Newhart and Jerry Vale in the Copa Room and Bobby Curtola in the Regency Lounge. Keep going and you'll find Debbie Reynolds in the Crystal Room of the Desert Inn with Loni Andal Quintet and Wanita Vess in the Goldcup Lounge.

Back across the Strip the Frontier has Wayne Newton and Dave Barry in the Music Hall, with Frank Ricci and Amy in the Winner's Circle Lounge.

Adjoining is the Silver Slipper with Leonard Stanley at the piano.

Up the Strip, a short walk, there's the Stardust with the extravaganza "Lido De Paris '74" in the Cafe Continental while Irish
