to be in the new government. Dayan's future is also uncertain. The NRP is expected to demand its vies on the Who Is A Jew question be accepted before it joins the coalition. The ILP is also expected to be tough in bargaining.

Premier Meir said she wished Rabin success in forming a new government "as soon as possible so that I can go home." Just prior to Rabin's selection Likud leader Ezer Weizman, a former commander of the Air Force, charged that Rabin had suffered a nervous breakdown while Chief of Staff on the eve of the 1967 Six-Day War and was incapable of making decisions thereafter. Rabin replied that he had called in Weizman to take over for a day so he could have some rest as he was exhausted. Another Likud leader, Gen. Ariel Sharon rebuked Weizman, saying "The army that won the Six-Day War was the army constructed by Rabin, prepared by Rabin for war and led by Rabin to victory."

**MRS. MEIR URGES ARABS TO CHOOSE PEACE**

JERUSALEM (WNS)- All Israel came to a standstill at 11 a.m. on the nation's Memorial Day as traffic and pedestrians stopped in response to the steady wailing of sirens. At the same moment ceremonies were beginning in the nation's military cemeteries.

Speaking at Kiryat Shemona, Premier-Golda Meir appealed to Israel's enemies to choose peace instead of war. "Even near these graves we call upon all our neighbors ...and say to them: Your sons too are falling," she said. "Perhaps the time really has come for you to listen to our appeal

for peace." Mrs. Meir warned the Arabs not to confuse Israel's sadness as a sign of weakness, noting that "the spirit of the people has not broken, for we do not have an alternative."

The principle rites were held at the military cemetery on Mt. Herzl overlooking Jerusalem.

Earlier Pres Ephraim Katzir lit the memorial candle at the Western Wall. Gen. Mordechai Gur, Chief of Staff, told the bereaved families that the country needed their continued faith "more than anything else" and their determination "to continue in the same way as your

dear ones." In the past Independence Day ceremonies began immediately after sundown when the Memorial Day ended. But out of respect for the thousands of Israeli families still mourning their dead in the Yom Kippur War this year the festivities did not begin until the next day.

**JEWISH LEADERS RAP U.N. RESOLUTION**

NEW YORK -- In a statement assailing the United Nations resolution condemning Israel for "violation of Lebanon's territorial integrity," the American Jewish Congress declared this week:

"The Security Council's censure of Israel for her retaliatory raid against terrorist nests in Lebanon, without any mention of the butchery at Kiryat Shemona that was its direct cause, is only the latest instance of the anti-Israel bias that pervades the United Nations.

"It is a dismal reminder that the UN is not an institution for the keeping of international peace but a forum for the venting of political vendettas and a loudspeaker for Arab propaganda.

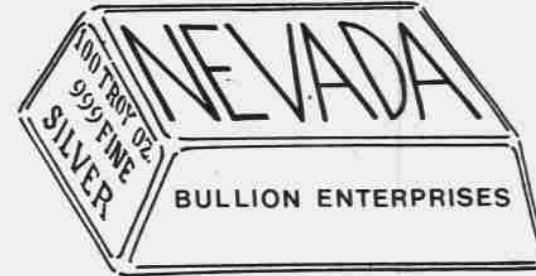
"We deeply regret that the U.S. delegate voted for this one-sided resolution. The honorable course for our country's representative would have been to veto it."
