motion a new round of meetings in Geneva. But according to reports from Damascus, thousands of persons marched through the streets there urging rejection of all peace proposals which do not meet Syria's terms, complete Israeli withdrawal from all land occupied since 1967 and recognition of the national rights of the Palestinians.

Prior to Kissinger's arrival some Israelis voiced pessimism over the Secretary's chance of reaching an agreement between Israel and Syria. They noted that the negotiating process with Syria will be tougher and more drawn out than it was with Egypt. Israelis are also concerned that the U.S. will try to impose undesirable terms on Israel.

Even within the Labor Alignment some members have expressed fear that the caretaker government may give in to pressure. Likud leader Menachem Beigin cut short a visit to the United States on behalf of the Israel Bond Organization after receiving an urgent call from Likud colleagues warning that the government was about to yield to American pressure.

Settlers in the Golan Heights sent a cablegram to the National Religious Party saying that the return of the Golan town of Kuneitra to the Syrians would mean the elimination of all settlements on the strategic Golan.

Meanwhile the semi-official Egyptian newspaper Al Ahram reported that Kissinger brought to Israel a four-point disengagement proposal that calls for the return of not only the 300 square miles of Syrian territory captured in the Yom Kippur War but also a 10-square mile slice of the Golan captured in the 1967 war, including Kuneitra.
