

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

NEW YORK,--Newton N. Minow, former chairman of the Federal Communications Commission, has been named chairman of the board of overseers of the Jewish Theological Seminary of America.

NEW YORK!--According to the National Conference on Soviet Jewry, Soviet Jewish dancer Valery Panov is now visited daily by the KGB, Soviet secret police, on charges of "parasitism."

NEW YORK (WNS) -- A record class of 56 new Reform rabbis were ordained by the Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion at commencement exercises in New York and Cincinnati.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The White House has announced that President Nixon will visit the Soviet Union starting June 27.

TEL AVIV (WNS) --- Outgoing Foreign Minister Abba Eban is indicating he may challenge Premier Yitzhak Rabin for the Labor Party leadership.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Minister after minister praised Premier Golda Meir for her five years of leadership as her Cabinet held its final session.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Israeli Ambassador Simcha Dinitz said that Israel was not pressured by the U.S. during the sessions in which Secretary of State Henry Kissinger negotiated an Israeli-Syrian disengagement agreement.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Syria has assured the United States that it will not give encouragement to terrorists, according to Rep. Robert Wilson (R, Cal.).

NEW YORK -- The American Jewish Congress announced the appointment of Rabbi David Clayman of Jerusalem, assistant dean of the Hebrew University School for Overseas Students, as its representative in Israel.

LONDON (WNS) --- Ten Soviet Jewish activists, all of whom have been denied exit visas, were detained by Soviet authorities, held for a weekend and then released.

SAN ANTONIO (WNS) -- The National Parent-Teachers Association has adopted a resolution denouncing the slaughter of Israeli school children by Arab terrorists in Maalot and urging President Nixon and Congress to sponsor resolutions in the United Nations condemning acts of terrorism in any part of the world.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- An immigrant transit home, able to accommodate up to 20 people, will be opened by the Jewish Agency's Immigration and Absorption Department in Beisan in the Jordan Valley.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The American Jewish Committee and the American Jewish Congress have been meeting on ways to coordinate their community relations activities in order to avoid duplication and increase their effectiveness.

PARIS (WNS) -- Simone Veil, who has been named as France's Health Minister, is both the only woman in the new French Cabinet and the only Jew.

LONDON (WNS) -- Thirteen Minsk Jews, many of them wounded or decorated veterans of the Red Army in World War II, have written to the Soviet Prosecutor-General Roman Rudenko asking him to start legal proceedings against the anti-Semitic Byelorussian poet, Maxim Luzhantsev, whose new collection contains more anti-Semitic poems echoing the tone and content of Nazi propaganda.

CHICAGO (WNS) -- A 26-kilometer walk to raise funds for the Jewish United Fund Israel Emergency Fund netted some \$200,000 here.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Twelve wounded Israeli prisoners of war returned from Syria and were reported to be in good condition.

opposition, whose leader Menachem Beigin has called the new government a national disgrace and the weakest in Israel's history, is trying to persuade the religious parties to vote against the government.

However, Rabin is expected to get the support of the pro-Moscow Rakah Communists and the far-left Moked faction.

Four veteran ministers will be missing from the new government: Premier Golda Meir, Foreign Minister Abba Eban, Defense Minister Moshe Dayan and Finance Minister Pinhas Sapir. The new Cabinet ministers in addition to Rabin are: Deputy Premier and Foreign Minister Yigal Allon; Defense Minister, Shimon Peres, Information Minister, Aharon Yariv; Minister of Education and Culture, Aharon Yadin; Minister of Commerce and Industry, Haim Barlev; Minister of Transportation, Gad Yaacobi; Police Minister, Shlomo Hillel, Justice Minister, Haim Zadok; Housing Minister, Yehoshua Rabinowitz; Labor Minister, Moshe Baram. Absorption Minister, Shalom Rosen; Health Minister, Victor Shemtov; Agriculture Minister, Aharon Uzzan, Tourism Minister, Moshe Kol; Communications Minister, Avraham Ofer; Ministers-Without-Portfolio, Shulamit Aoni of the CRP, Gideon Hausner of the ILP and Israel Galili of Labor.

Rabin has also named Yaacov Levinson, an executive of the Hitadrut-owned Bank Hapoalim as Finance Minister but he cannot assume the office for another three months. Aadok will serve as Finance Minister as well as Justice Minister during that period. The Premier-designate is also holding open the three NRP Cabinet posts for a limited time should the NRP change its mind and join the government. These are Interior, Religious Affairs and Welfare.

Eban, meanwhile, who refused to accept the position of Information Minister offered him by Rabin, made a bitter speech during the Labor Party meeting on the new government in which he said it was wrong to pretend that Rabin wanted him in the government. He wondered aloud whether the nation would continue to look to the Party for leadership. Dayan promised to vote for the Rabin government but only "under duress." Mrs. Meir is also expected to take the same position since she has vowed not to support any government that includes Ms. Aloni.

FULBRIGHT'S DEFEAT ISRAEL'S GAIN
WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Although Israel was not an issue in the Arkansas primary election, Israel is expected to gain from the defeat of Sen. J. William Fulbright by Arkansas Gov. Dale Bumpers. Fulbright, head of the powerful Senate Foreign Relations Committee for 15 of his 30 years in Congress, frequently opposed aid for Israel.

Bumpers in a television debate with Fulbright said it was better to send arms than men to Israel.

Fulbright will probably be replaced as chairman of the Foreign Relations Committee, assuming the Democrats maintain their Senate majority after the November elections, by either Sen. John Sparkman of Alabama or Sen. Frank Church of Idaho, both sympathetic to Israel.
