NEW YORK -- The Kissinger "miracle" in negotiating a disengagement between Syria and Israel would not have been possible without Israeli courage, according to Mrs. Charlotte Jacobson, Chairman of the World Zionist Organization -- American Section, who has just returned to the United States from a tour of Australia.

ONE VOTE MAJORITY FOR RABIN'S CABINET

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Yitzhak Rabin's Cabinet, made up of a coalition of the Labor Alignment, the Independent Liberal Party and the Civil Rights Party, was sworn in after receiving a 61-51 vote in the Knesset.

One Labor MK, Mordechai Ben Porat of the Rafi faction abstained and was joined by the four Raka Communists. But Meir Payil, of the left Moked, voted for the Rabin government giving it a one-vote majority in the 120 seat Knesset. Likud was joined by the National Religious Party and the Aguda bloc in opposing the new coalition.

However, Rabin is still holding open the three NRP Cabinet posts should the party change its mind, and decide to join the government.

The only last minute change in the Cabinet was the appointment of former Tel Aviv Mayor Yehoshua Rabinowitz as Finance Minister replacing Pinhas Sapir who retired from the government. Rabinowitz, who had been slated as Housing Minister, was persuaded by the Labor Party to take the post after banker Yaacov Levinson decided not to join the Cabinet. Abraham Offer, who was to be Communications Minister, was instead

named as Housing Minister with Rabin temporarily holding the Communications post too.

The 52-year old Rabin is Israel's youngest prime minister and the first native born Israeli to hold the job.

Earlier in asking the Knesset to approve the government, Rabin said he would follow the same course as Premier Golda Meir, making changes and innovations when needed. He said his new government would pursue a policy of cautious, step-by-step peace negotiations with Israel's Arab neighbors, strengthening the national security and tackling the numerous social and economic problems at home. He said Israel was ready to reach a settlement

with Jordan but stated that "Israel rejects the establishment of a further separate state west of the Jordan."
