An Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith survey revealed that some 126 radio stations around the country are carrying "This Is Liberty Lobby," a daily extremist program controlled by a professional organizer of anti-Jewish groups and publications. In addition to the current outlets, the League said, a recent contract signed with the Mutual Broadcasting System will make the program available to Mutual's network of more than 600 stations.

In making the survey public, Harvey B. Schechter, Acting Director of ADL's Pacific Southwest Regional Office, said Willis A. Carto, "an outspoken anti-Semite," is "the unpublicized force" behind "This Is Liberty Lobby," a five-minute broadcast carried by most of the stations on a paid basis but on some as a public service. Carto is the founder and boss of Liberty Lobby, a 16 year old Washington-based propaganda and lobbying organization which has become one of the most active and best financed groups on the American far right.

Commenting on the new Mutual Broadcasting System tie-in, Mr. Schechter said "the contract hardly came as a surprise since Mutual's principal owners, Mr. and Mrs. Benjamin D. Gilbert, have contributed thousands of dollars to Liberty Lobby since 1966."

Were you aware that the ad you recently ran which offered a free new testament "for synagogue or home comparative religion study" was made by a Hebrew-Christian Group? The new testament offered was one used by Christians and does not belong in a Jewish home or synagogue.

The ad gave no hint as to its misleading purpose, which is to extol Christianity to those of the Jewish faith. The bible lessons they offer end with pleas to accept Christ.

That the only English-Jewish newspaper in Nevada should accept and run such an ad makes me feel ill. I think you owe your readers an apology and an explanation of why you ran such an ad.

Dear Miss Brotsky:

You are right and we were wrong. We could offer the lame excuse that we were indiscreet, but that would not be true. We were plain dumb. We should have taken a second look for hidden intent when the ad came in the mail.

As you say in your letter, Miss Brotsky, the ad gave no hint as to its misleading purpose. That is the sole reason we regret running the ad. We are sorry we played a part in deceiving our readers. A mistake was made and we apologize. Does that satisfy you, Miss Brotsky?

But wait. Let's not stop here. Suppose we explore the subject a little deeper.

Upon careful reflection, had the ad stated, in plain view, its real intention, we probably would have run it without any compunction. What would be wrong with the ad? It would not have been anti-Semitic. It would not have been pro-Nazi or pro-Arab terrorist. It would be an ad seeking to convert Jews to Christianity.

Miss Brotsky, as a Jew and a Jewish editor, there is nothing we fear less than an uncertain Jew who desires to change his religion. Let him go.

You see, Miss Brotsky, Judaism is an unusual, one-of-a-kind faith. We are exclusive. We send out no missionaries. We make conversion an ordeal, not simple or easy. It takes stamina to be a Jew and to remain one. We have a religion to be proud of.

If another religion wants to recruit from ours, let it. Any Jew, who is not content with

PALESTINIANS NOT INVITED TO GENEVA

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger has denied that the United States and Soviet Union have agreed to invite the Palestinians to the Middle East peace conference in Geneva.

The joint communique issued by President Nixon and Soviet Communist Party leader Leonid Brezhnev at the end of the third summit conference referred to the "legitimate interests of all peoples in the Middle East, in-

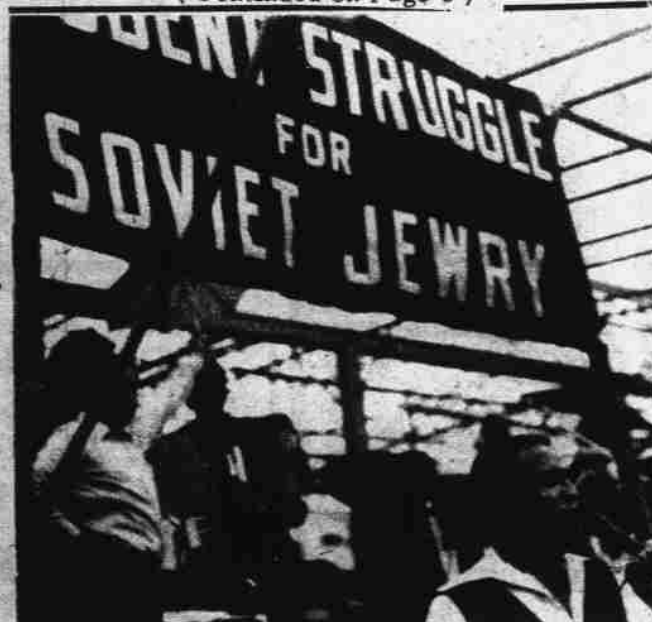
cluding the Palestinians." The communique also said that the U.S. and the Soviet Union as co-chairmen of the Geneva conference "consider it important that the conference resume its work as soon as possible, with the question of other participants from the Middle East area to be discussed at the conference."

Kissinger said at a news conference that there was "absolutely" no agreement to bring in the Palestinians as participants.

KISSINGER ACCUSED OF BRUTALIZING ISRAEL

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Prof. Gil Carl Alroy, of the Middle Eastern Studies Department at Hunter College, has charged the Nixon Administration and Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger with willingness to "brutalize" Israel so that a demoralized Jewish state would be willing to make concessions leading to a piecemeal withdrawal to its pre-June 1967 borders.

He said that these borders under 1974 conditions would make for an even more dangerous situation in the Mideast.
