Yigal Allon has left for the United States where he is expected to discuss the next stage of the Geneva peace conference.

Allon is scheduled to meet with Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger, Defense Secretary James R. Schlesinger and Treasury Secretary William Simon. He will also discuss economic and military aid for Israel.

Former Israeli Air Force commander Mordechai Hod, now an assistant to Defense Minister Shimon Peres is already in Washington discussing military aid promised during President Nixon's visit.

Meanwhile, there is some indication that Israel is ready to negotiate with Jordan and will no longer insist that talks with Egypt have priority. The reason for this, according to political observers, is that the normalization process on the Suez Canal is proceeding slowly.

TELL TALES

"One Man Plus The Truth
Constitutes A Majority"

Corruption at L.V. Sun

Readers of this column are well aware of the complaints we have lodged over the years against Las Vegas Sun publisher Hank Greenspun and his chief columnist Paul Price, but when their journalistic filth permeates down into the ranks of reporters on the street, it is a sad commentary on the state of the American press.

The offense we charge, of deliberately omitting an important statement from their stories, is even more grievous because the staff writers involved, Harold Hyman and Ed Dodrill, are unquestionably, generally honest reporters who know their business. In this instance they apparently leaned to the weight on the paper. How are we to know whether any stories under their bylines are honest reports?

Ladies and gentlemen, this writer, Jack Tell, was personally on hand to witness what we are going to tell you about. We were told by Price himself what we believe (because of subsequent information) to be a deliberate lie when he said he had been given permission by Supreme Court Justice David Zenoff to print a letter marked personal and confidential.

In addition, although Greenspun clarified the Sun's position of "overplaying" Mr. Kaufman's part in the story, which Greenspun said, "should have been relegated to a less prominent position in the paper," he compounded the trans-

gression by permitting a subsequent story to commit the same journalistic abuse that violated honesty in the first story. Mind you, this took place AFTER Greenspun specifically stated: "The real purpose of this clarification is to assure Jerry Kaufman that we are not taking sides in his election contest, and to assure him and other candidates, that a more careful look will be taken at matters affecting local elections."

Let us see how careful Greenspun actually looked.

We hasten to add at this point that what is happening at the Las Vegas Sun is not indicative of any other daily newspaper in the United States, and the newspaper business as a whole is a profound, honest, responsible profession deserving of the highest respect.

Here is a short summary of the background to the events that took place last week:

Jerry Kaufman, an Alternate Municipal Judge, is a candidate for District Judge, Dept. 4. He is pictured with his wife Bunny, who is President of Sisterhood of Temple Beth Shalom, and their children.

Hyman's Page 1 story led with charges made against Kaufman by a newly appointed Justice of the Peace in a court order dismissing a case against a man accused of murder. The incidence of a murder charge dismissal in a

LATE NEWS FLASH

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- A GROUP OF 150 JEWISH SETTLERS, WHO SOUGHT TO ESTABLISH A SETTLEMENT AT SEBASTIA, NEAR THE WEST BANK TOWN OF NABLUS, DECIDED TO LEAVE THEIR ENCAMPMENT WHERE THEY HAD BEEN FOR TWO DAYS IN ORDER TO AVERT A CONFRONTATION WITH THE ISRAELI ARMY. A SPOKESMAN FOR THE SETTLERS, MOST OF THEM ORTHODOX, SAID THEY WERE NOT LEAVING OF THEIR OWN FREE WILL BUT IN ORDER TO AVERT A CLASH. DEFENSE MINISTER SHIMON PERES HAD TOLD THE SETTLERS THAT IN LINE WITH A CABINET DECISION THEY WOULD BE REMOVED IF THEY DID NOT LEAVE.
