

WEST BANK JEWS TO BE CONTROLLED BY ISRAEL

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Premier Yitzhak Rabin, while on a tour of the West Bank, told settlers that Jewish settlements in the Jordan Valley area of the West Bank were established on the assumption they would remain under Israeli control in any agreement with Jordan.

The settlers had asked about news reports that the settlements would be turned

over to Jordan in a peace agreement.

Defense Minister Shimon Peres told a meeting of the Working Mothers Association in Haifa that Israel is ready to discuss with Jordan the future of the West Bank which would include "a political compromise" allowing the people there "to develop a national life of their own." Peres declared that the

Palestine Liberation Organization not Israel threatens Jordan. He said Israel would not negotiate with the terrorists because she did not want a PLO takeover of most of Jordan or Soviet infiltration there.

Commerce and Industry Minister Haim Barlev told agriculture students in Rehovot that Israel would not deal with any group on the West Bank which wants to create a separate state between Israel and Jordan.

The minister's comments came after the Knesset discussed the Cabinet statement that Israel would negotiate only with Jordan not with any terrorist organizations.

Nissim Eliad of the Independent Liberal Party urged greater readiness to negotiate with any Palestinian group that would recognize Israel's right.

KISSINGER MEETS 17 JEWISH LEADERS

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Seventeen American Jewish leaders met with Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger to discuss the Middle East, American economic and military support of Israel, the plight of Soviet and Syrian Jews.


Rabbi Israel Miller chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, and Max Fisher, chairman of the board of governors of the Jewish Agency, described the meeting, the first since President Nixon's trip to Israel and the Moscow summit conference, as comprehensive, candid, constructive and friendly.

Just prior to the meeting Kissinger met with Rabbi Miller, Fisher and Stanley H. Lowell, chairman of the National Conference on Soviet Jewry, to discuss

the issue of Jewish emigration from the USSR. The three Jewish leaders said the American Jewish community wanted an end to the harassment of Jews seeking to emigrate, free emigration for all who applied for exit visas and the release of "Prisoners of Conscience," Jews who are in prison only for the "crime" of wishing to go to Israel.

Kissinger said he understood their concern and was actively pursuing the matter.
