

### MIKE SCHAEFER FOR SECY. OF STATE

Attorney Mike Schaefer, 36, is the son of western pioneers. His grandparents settled Silver City, New Mexico over 100 years ago, migrating to California where young Mike was born on March 25, 1938. Attending local public schools, Mike went to the University of Notre Dame to study engineering, then graduated in accounting from the University of California.

Fascinated by the law that governs our life, Mike worked his way through Georgetown Law Center in Washington, D.C., working part time as a financial analyst with the federal Securities and Exchange Commission and later as a Deputy Clerk for the U.S. District Court where the Watergate trials have taken place. He also worked as a volunteer in the main-room of his U.S. Senator, to learn more about politics in government. Always an active student, Mike served as President of the Associated Men Students as an undergraduate and worked on the school paper at Georgetown.

Assistant City Prosecutor serving with distinction until election to the City Council where he worked with budgets exceeding \$100,000,000, retiring at the end of his term to enter private law practice. Mike was elected Republican nominee for the U. S. Congress in 1968 and was endorsed by Sheriff and Police Department associations in a bid for District Attorney, prior to moving his family to the Silver State. Mike Schaefer is listed in Who's Who in the West, and Who's Who in American Politics during the mid sixties in recognition of his activity as a local legislator.
