Joining Phyllis both on and off stage, in the audience, and in the constant parade of comedy confusion are musical groups, SWING and THE MARK & CLARK EXPEDITION, magician MARCER HELMS, actors/writers PAT McCORMACK & MARC LONDON, and a St. Bernard.
