

STOLDAL HOSTS KLAS-TV NEW MORNING COMMUNITY AFFAIRS SHOW

A MAJOR expansion of KLAS-TV's Community Affairs Department commenced this week, it was announced by Mark Smith, General Manager of the Las Vegas CBS Television Network station.

"Because of the increasing growth of Southern Nevada, we decided an enlargement of our Community Affairs Department was necessary to continue our program of efficiently serving the needs and interests of Clark County residents," Smith said.

"This expansion will include the appointment of Robert Stoldal, who has been serving as Editorial Director and Night News Editor for KLAS-TV, as Community Affairs Director," Smith added.

Stoldal, presently anchorman on the 11:00 P.M. Report, will be acting host of the new daily program, "The Morning Show," starting August 19, 1974.

Smith explained that the "Morning Show" will continue to feature a five-minute news segment with Andrea Boggs reporting, along with taking a practical and complete look at Las Vegas. A wide variety of topics will be covered on the new "Morning Show" ranging from milk prices and the Equal Rights Amendment to discussion on pornography and how to buy a new or used car.

Jimmie Lou Alexander will retire from her present duties of producing the "Woman-kind" program and move into a newly scheduled weekend feature dubbed "Sunday." During this half-hour show each week, Jimmie will "hold a mirror to the city of Las Vegas" which will include special guests and interesting film features.

The overall goal of the newly restaffed Community Affairs Department is to provide the community with the most efficient, innovative and responsive programming possible. Gregg Cooper will continue producing all local Public Service spots with an accent on local community needs, in addition to producing the "Morning Show" with Robert Stoldal.

While acting in its present form, the KLAS-TV Public Ser-

vice Department has become the largest and most complete of its kind in the State of Nevada and employs its own crew for filming documentaries and PSA spots.

Along with the responsibility of the "Morning Show" and "Sunday," the newly created Public Affairs Department will include "Spanish News," "Let's Talk" and "AM/PM" in its production schedule in addition to any special programming of community interest.
