

## JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- Ambassador Jacob Barmore, Israel's observer to the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities, was not permitted to complete his statement on the plight of Soviet Jews and the persecution of Syrian Jewry.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Egyptian Minister Ismail Fahmy concluded a week of discussions in Washington with President Ford, Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger and congressional leaders with a joint communique signed by him and Kissinger in which they agreed to "the right of existence of all states" in the Middle East. While the statement did not mention Israel by name it did put Egypt on record as recognizing the existence of the Jewish state.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Heinrich Spetter, the Bulgarian Jewish economist who has been sentenced to death in Bulgaria for spying has arrived in Israel.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The United States will continue to help Israel and the Arab states find a way of solving their conflict and achieving a lasting peace in the Middle East, Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger told the American Legion Convention in Miami Beach.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- A statement that a marked improvement has taken place in immigration absorption facilities and strenuous efforts were being made for further improvements was issued here by the office of Jewish Agency Chairman Pinhas Sapir.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- A new writers union, the Israel Writers Union, has been formed to include 10 Arab and 23 Jewish writers.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- A powerful explosive charge was found in a baby carriage in the Nathan Yehuda market area and defused before it exploded.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The American Jewish Congress has denounced as "morally indefensible" plans by the first film festival in Telluride, Colorado, to honor Nazi propagandist Leni Riefenstahl.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- With rabbinical approval, dried pig skin is being used in grafts for Israeli soldiers who were severely burned during the Yom Kippur War.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Kol Israel reported this week that Sylvia Zalmanson, one of the defendants in the first Leningrad trial, was freed from Potma prison where she was serving a ten-year sentence.

LONDON (WNS) -- Col. Yefim Davidovich of Minsk, a much decorated hero of World War II has lost his army pension because he applied for an exit visa to Israel.

ELIZABETH, N. J. (WNS) -- The Soviet Ministry of Cults at the request of the head of the Moscow Jewish community has sent a special commission to Radin, near Vilna, to investigate a report that the ancient Jewish cemetery there had been levelled. Rabbi Pinhas Teitz, a former member of the Presidium of the Union of Orthodox Rabbis of the United States and Canada, said he learned that in the cemetery devastation the grave of the Chofetz Chaim, regarded as the greatest Talmudic scholar of modern times, who died in 1933, had disappeared.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- During a private dinner meeting hosted by Israeli Ambassador Simcha Dinitz, Jewish leaders from 27 U.S. communities pledged "significantly greater gifts to the 1975 United Jewish Appeal Campaign."

LONDON (WNS) -- British Jews will be asked to contribute 1 million pounds for Israel's needy border villages and towns during the 1974 Kol Nidre Appeal for Israel.

LONDON (WNS) -- A Jewish reporter, recently returned from Greece, has reported a climate hostile to Israel with clear anti-Semitic overtones has developed there because of the Cyprus crisis.
