

MOSCOW SEMINAR PURELY SCIENTIFIC

NEW YORK (WNS)-- The International Board of Sponsors and Advisors for the International Scientific Seminar scheduled to be held in the Moscow home of a prominent Jewish

scientist has rejected the Soviet charge that the confab is a "provocation action of certain circles."

Prof. Edward Stern of the University of Michigan, a spokesman for the group, declared that the seminar is "a purely scientific gathering, being conducted in accordance with usual international scientific standards."

The advisory board for the seminar includes eight Nobel Laureates, more than 100 scientific papers, including 75 from the West, will be presented at the conference to be held in the home of Alexander Voronel.

"Our Soviet Jewish colleagues who are ostracized by official Soviet science and denied access to normal scientific channels because they seek to emigrate to Israel, need the opportunity to exchange scientific information with their colleagues outside the Soviet Union," Dr. Stern said.

The State Committee for Science and Technology, the scientific arm of the Soviet Council of Ministers, has disowned the seminar and Soviet authorities have indicated that it will be opposed.

BLACKS WARNED AGAINST ANTI-SEMITISM

NEW YORK (WNS) -- A Black psychiatrist who teaches at the Harvard Medical School has warned that Blacks who promote anti-Semitism may be falling into a trap laid by their enemies.

Writing in Ebony magazine, Dr. Alvin F. Poussaint said: "The historic alliance between Jews and Blacks have been important to the individual advancement of both groups and the Black commun-

ity should not relinquish this alliance on either the Israeli dispute, or quota arguments."

Dr. Poussaint called for affirmative action

among Blacks and Jews to bring their social conflicts into perspective so that they could work together for an equal share of power and opportunity in American society.
