

NAT ADLER FOR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATOR

Nat Adler, prominent insurance agency owner and Tax Accountant is candidate for the office of Public Administrator this year.

Adler, who owns the insurance agency which bears his name, is also president of Vegas Enterprises, Inc., a finance company, and is licensed as both a real estate broker and insurance broker in the State of Nevada.

"The main complaint with the present Public Administrator's Office," Adler said, "is a lack of availability and communication with the public and with lawyers who have business there."

The decision to run for Public Administrator came, according to Adler, at the insistence of many members of the legal profession with whom he does business and with whom he is affiliated socially and fraternally.

Adler said that if he is elected he proposes to open suitable offices in a convenient location and maintain them under regular business hours, the same as other official agencies. "This is not the case at the present time," he pointed out.
