EGYPT VERY ANXIOUS FOR PEACE TALKS

PARIS (WNS) -- Egypt Foreign Minister Jean Sauvagnargues announced that France will help Egypt in its efforts to rebuild her economy but would not give the amount of the loan.

He also announced he will visit Cairo in October, the same month he is scheduled to go to Israel.

Egyptian Foreign Minister Ismail Fahmy in telling this to French President Valery Giscard d'Estaing, stressed that any delay "could endanger the precarious ceasefire in the Middle East." Fahmy said Egypt will coordinate its plans with Syrian and the Palestinians and then Jordan will be brought into the discussions and "we shall go to Geneva again."

It was announced here during Fahmy's visit that Egyptian President Anwar Sadat and Giscard d'Estaing will exchange visits before the end of the year. Sadat's visit could come next month when he is scheduled to address the Council of Europe in Strasbourg.

RELIGIOUS LEADERS IN CHILE AID POLITICAL PRISONERS

Rabbi Rubin R. Dobin of Lawrence, New York, a leader in American Section of Amnesty International has released the following statement regarding the violation of human rights by the Chilean Junta. Rabbi Dobin is making this statement on behalf of the American Section, Amnesty International USA.

"Amnesty International of the USA applauds the joint ecumenical efforts of Rabbi Angel Kreiman, Mngr. Fernando Ariztia Ruiz, and Rev. Helmut Frenz on behalf of the political detainees in Chile. Their concern for the breach of international law in Chile is shared by Amnesty International.

"In amnesty's view, these religious leaders have aided the cause of human rights immensely by revealing the gross violations in Chile and by giving courage to those desperately needing help, individuals who have found themselves the victims of arbitrary arrest, held anonymously and incommunicado, denied the right to legal counsel and faced with the real possibility of torture & summary execution."

Rabbi Dobin explained that Rabbi Kreiman is the Chief Rabbi of Chile, Msgr. Fernando Ruiz is Auxiliary of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Santiago, and Rev. Frenz is Lutheran Bishop of Chile and leader of the country's Protestant Church groups. Rabbi Dobin can be reached at POB 11, Lawrence, New York, 11559.

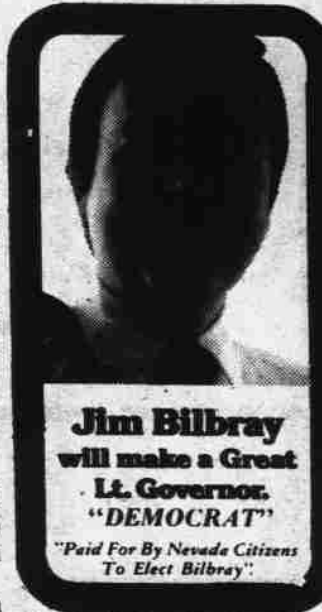
