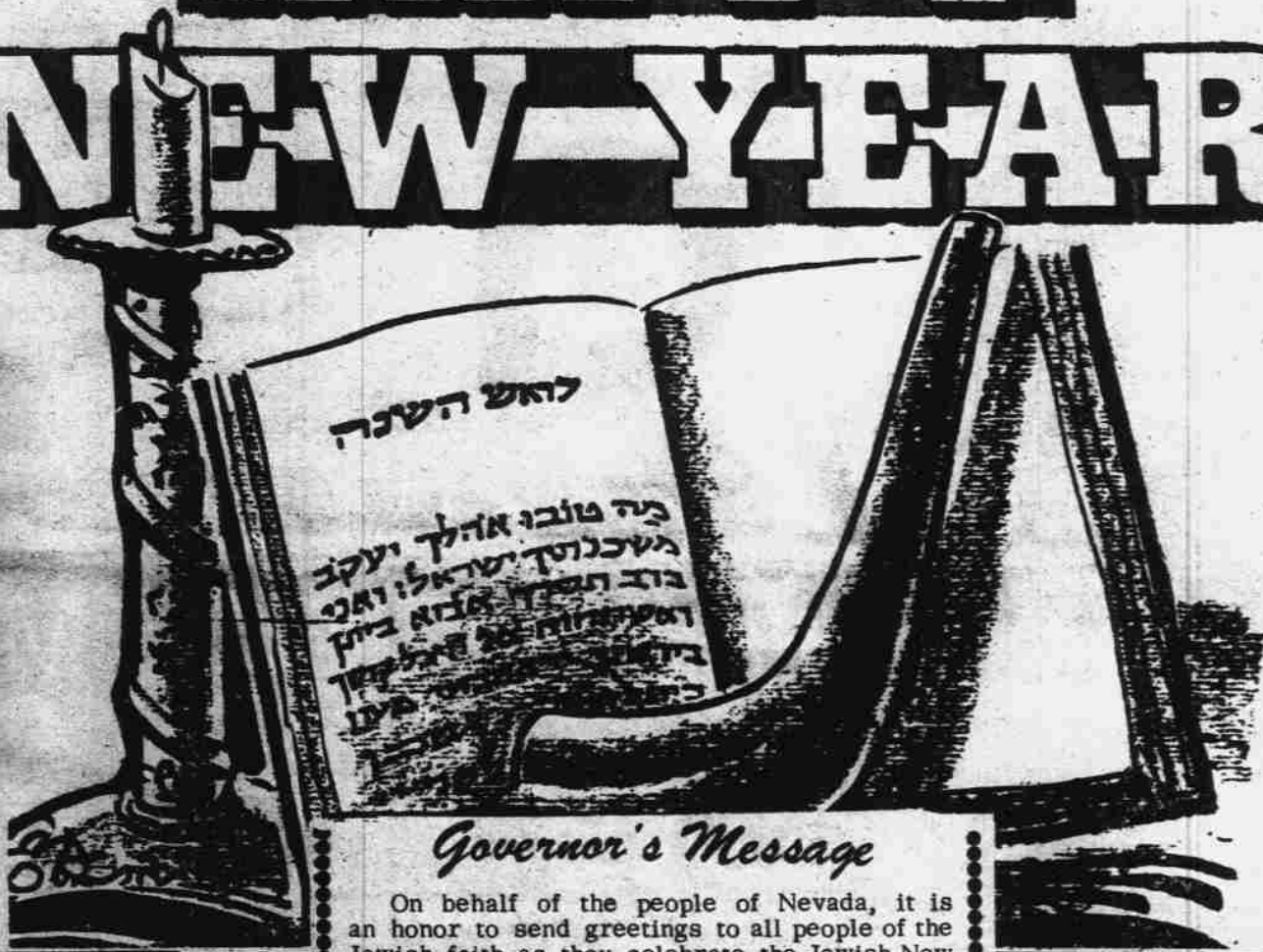

MONTREAL (WNS) --
Israeli Premier Yitzhak
Rabin has asked American
and Canadian Jewry for
increased economic aid
to Israel during the
next four months in the
face of Israel's pressing
post-war financial
needs.

Rabin's plea came in a
cabled message from
Jerusalem to Sam
Rothberg, general
chairman of the Israel
Bond Organization, and
Michael Arnon, chief
executive officer, during
the four-day International
Leadership Conference of
the Bond Organization here.
Rabin urged the more
than 750 American and
Canadian Jewish leaders
attending the conference
to take "immediate steps
to utilize the critical fall
period to mobilize the
greatest possible cash
sale of Israel Bonds to
enable us to continue

Later in an address to
the meeting, Israel
Defense Minister
Shimon Peres, also

stressed that Israel is
depending on the Jews
of the United States and
the rest of the free world
for large-scale financial
aid through the
Israel Bond Organization.
He noted that while
Israel has accumulated a
deficit of \$5 billion as a
result of four wars and
its development program,
the Arabs have a surplus
of \$45 billion this year.

The Ford Dilemma. Uncovering the Coverup

We predict that President Gerald Ford's
pardon of ex-President Nixon, to put an end
to what he called "An American Tragedy,"
will have just the opposite effect.

Apart from the obvious rumblings we have
been hearing over and over again all this week,
the can of worms opened by President Ford
will have far greater significance than the
original Watergate that led to Nixon's resignation.

Perhaps not a majority, but a great many
Americans have remained loyal to Nixon, in-
cluding some who have served time in jail
on his behalf, others now serving time, others
under indictment facing a jail sentence and
still others under cloud of being indicted.
All, except John Dean, have stood firmly and
