CANADA SOLID BEHIND ISRAEL

OTTAWA (WNS)---- Canada's "standing policy is the recognition of Israel's right to exist in a climate of peace under secure and recognized borders," Mitchell Sharp, Sec'y of State for Foreign Affairs, told the third annual dinner for 150 Parliamentary member on Israel's 26th anniversary.

Sharp called for negotiations to solve the Mideast conflict and condemned the terrorists attack on Kiryat Shemona "regardless of the aims."

At the dinner sponsored by the Canada-Israel Committee, leaders of Canada's two other parties joined with Sharp, a liberal, in expressing Canada's solidarity with Israel. "The challenge to Israel's friends is to do what our decency requires -- help Israel to reach peace," Robert Stanfield, pres. of the Progressive Conservative Party, declared. Noting that he admired Holland for resisting pressure, he said: "May be someday it will be our time to be tested

for our will to resist pressure."
