

New Year Message

At the beginning of the religious New Year 5735, we join with the household of Israel everywhere in the prayers and spiritual stock-taking which are part of the special observance of the High Holy Days. Let us rededicate our lives to our faith and pray for the attainment of Judaism's message which is universal in its call for peace, justice, and dignity for all humanity.

During these sacred days, our hearts and

strong support accompany our prayers for Israel and our fellow Jews in the Soviet Union. Our fervent hope is that a final just peace settlement between Israel and her Arab neighbors will be realized. Likewise, we pray and strive for a change in Soviet policy which will permit unlimited emigration for Jews and other citizens, as well as religious and cultural freedom for all people who remain within her borders.

As we affirm the basic tenets and traditions of Judaism in this solemn period of the Days of Awe, we recall the teachings of our Prophets "to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with Thy God." Our faith calls upon each of us to advance the cause of social justice; to engage in study and spread knowledge; and to give personal commitment, service and assistance to others.

The National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, whose program serves Jewish and humanitarian causes, includes more than 100,000 Jewish women in 630 Sisterhoods throughout the United States and in cities of Canada and 13 other countries of the United Nations. It is engaged in a diversified program which includes service to local synagogues and communities; work on behalf of the blind; religious and family education; intergroup relations; projects of social justice; support for Israel and Soviet Jewry; youth activities; rabbinic student aid; service to the elderly; and efforts to improve international understanding.

NFTS is the women's agency of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, the central organization of Reform Judaism in America, and is affiliated with the World Union for Progressive Judaism.

LOS ANGELES (WNS) -- One hundred Los Angeles Jews, dressed in striped prison shirts and white yarmulkes, staged a silent protest in support of Soviet Jewry, during the opening performance of the Bolshoi Ballet at the Shrine Auditorium here.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- New York State political figures joined with Jewish groups at the New York Stock Exchange to launch a three-day "Freedom Hunger Strike" on behalf of Jews in the Soviet Union and Arab countries.
