SEN. CANNON'S INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Applications are now being accepted for the Sen. Howard Cannon Internship Program, which allows a University of Nevada, Las Vegas student to spend the spring semester in the Washington office of the Nevada senator.

The candidate selected will work in the office of Sen. Cannon and receive remuneration of \$400 per month, plus travel expenses.

The internship is open to any UNLV senior or first-year graduate student, according to Dr. Albert C. Johns, chairman of the screening committee.

Application, including the student's collegiate transcript, three letters of recommendation, and an essay in not more than 1,000 words on why the student is seeking the internship, should be submitted to the political science secretary, Social Sciences 239, on or before
