would regard such a resolution as "impinging on its fundamental rights, as illegal and not binding in any way... One cannot ask of any nation to agree to its own elimination or to commit suicide."

He warned that the Assembly agenda is designed to destroy the prospects for a peaceful solution in the Mideast.

Referring to the Yom Kippur War, Allon asserted that it was proof "there cannot be, and there never will be a military solution of the Arab-Israeli conflict." He accused the Soviet Union of "incitement to intransigence and inflexibility" in the Middle East, "one of the principle causes of tension," in the region. He also accused the Arab states of perpetuating the refugee problem since 1948 "in order to exploit human suffering for political and propaganda end."

Allon drew attention to the plight of Jews in Syria and expressed the hope that "as an act of humanity" they will be allowed to leave. He also urged the Soviet Union to allow Jews to emigrate which "will not only solve an agonizing Jewish problem which is unique in history, but, I believe, will also provide the solution for a Soviet problem with which the Soviet government has struggled for many years."

Expressing appreciation for what has been done, he appealed to the USSR "to show greater generosity, to cease harassing those who have applied to emigrate, to release the prisoners of Zion, to open the gates, and they will earn the praise of civilized men everywhere for their humanity."

'GOOD SIGNS FOR EXPECTED PROGRESS'

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Israeli Foreign Minister Yigal Allon emerged from a two-hour "working breakfast" meeting with Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger to say that "I see good signs for expected progress" in the Middle East negotiations.

But Allon said that his impression is that the Arab countries are not now ready to negotiate a final peace settlement. He said the chances are that the next stage will be negotiations for interim settlements which would be comprised of a re-deployment of forces and territorial changes and changing the present situation from cease-fire to a state of non-belligerency.

Kissinger met with Allon and the foreign ministers of Syria and Egypt in preparation for his visit to Egypt, Syria, Jordan and Israel Oct. 9-11, his eighth trip to


the Middle East. Allon said most of his meeting with Kissinger concerned the American attitude at the current General Assembly session.

Allon said that there has been no change in the U. S. policy on the Palestinian issue. He said he told Kissinger that a UN debate on the "Palestine Question" could poison and endanger the expected resumption of the Geneva peace conference on the Middle East. Allon said that Israel's position remains that the Palestinian identity issue could be resolved in the context of a peace agreement between Israel and Jordan.

Earlier in a television interview, Allon categorically rejected the Palestine Liberation Organization as the representative of the Palestinians.
