CLARENCE SUNDEAN FOR DIST. JUDGE

District Court Judge Clarence Sundean stated that he will continue to use N.R.S. 193.165; when applicable, in sentencing persons convicted of using a firearm or other deadly weapon in the commission of a crime.

This statute provides that any person who uses a firearm or other deadly weapon in the commission of a crime shall be punished by imprisonment prescribed by statute

for such crime. "The Nevada legislature has seen fit to grant judges an additional tool to use in the continuing battle to rid our community of the dangerous criminal element," Judge Sundean explained, "and I intend to use the law, when it is applicable, to help in the fight to protect our community from the violence foisted upon the people, by dangerous criminals," he stated. According to Judge

BILL BYRNE FOR COUNTY ASSESSOR

Sundean, the statute provides that the use of a firearm or other deadly weapon in the commission of a crime is not a separate offense, but an increased penalty.

"If someone wishes to question the constitutionality of the law, it is his privilege," Judge

Sundean added, "However, I will continue to impose the increased penalty for the benefit of the community," Judge Sundean concluded.....

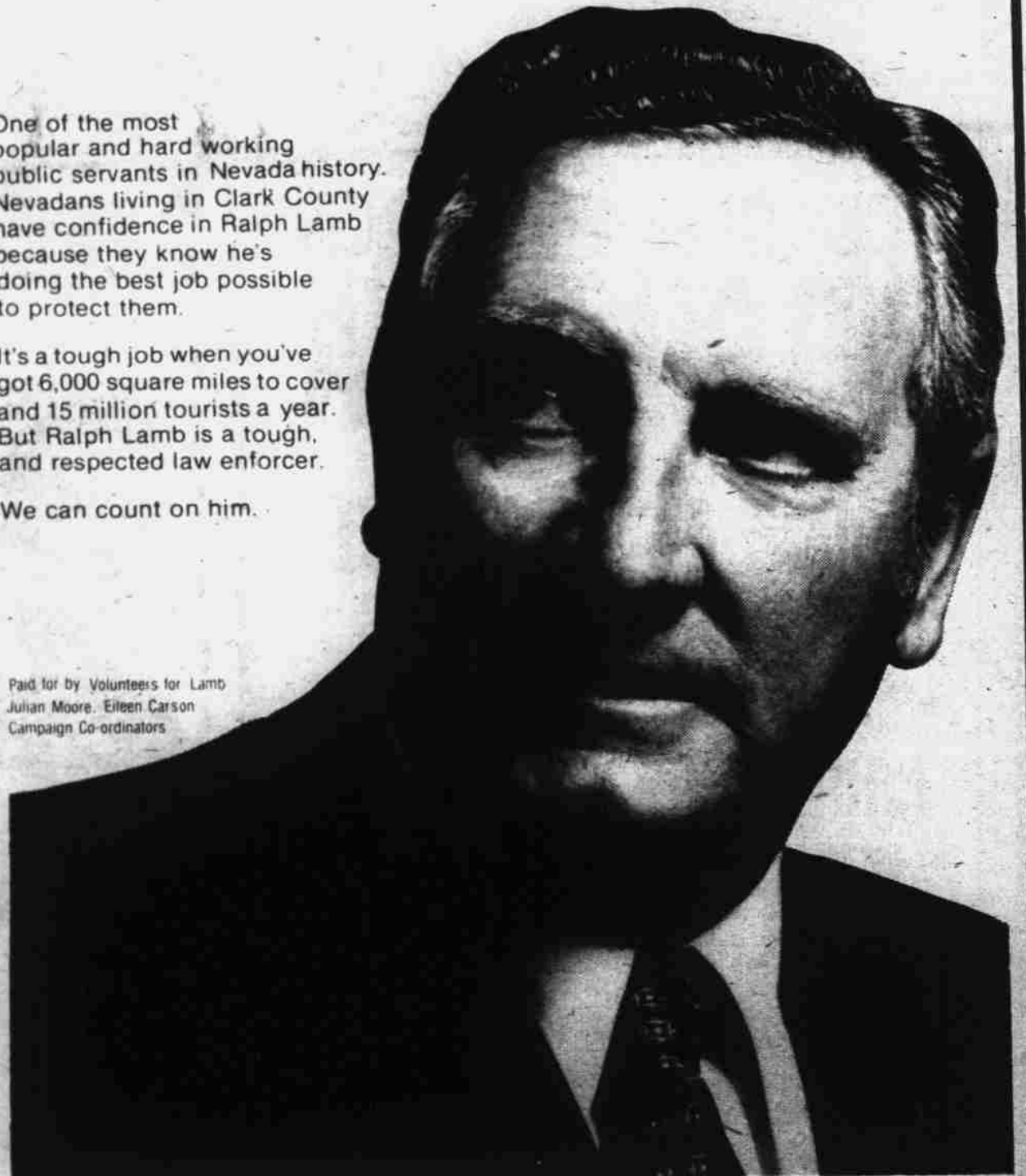
