Miss Zalmanson, who was freed last August after serving four of her 10-year sentence, was welcomed at City Hell by Mayor Abraham Beame and more than 100 Jewish community leaders and activists on behalf of Soviet Jew-Beame noted that her "heroic struggle to reach Israel typifies the plight of many Jews in the USSR who have been imprisoned solely for the 'crime' of wishing to emigrate to that nation."
