## RABAT DECISION BY

Dr. Joseph Sternstein, President of the Zionist Organization of America, reacted to the Arab decision at Rabat by stating: "Since the Arabs know beyond doubt that Israel cannot possibly accept establishment of PLO dominion over any area of the West Bank. the Rabat decision unmistakably signals, a rejection by the Arabs of any intention of working seriously toward a negotiated settlement. This decision has done a grave disservice to the Palestinian people and has erected further barriers to the possibility of any just and last-ing peace in the Middle East."

Dr. Sternstein con-tinued: "The Rabat Rabat decision should serve to whatever redispell maining illusions exist in our country about the nature of Arab intentions. Prodded by the Russians, the Arabs have made clear that they indeed have not renounced their ultimate of destroying Israel, and that the only interim solution that they will accept is one designed to set the stage for this final denouement.

"Under the cumstances, Israel has no choice but to stand firm and to proceed to take the steps necessary to provide for her security. With the Arab decision slamming shut the door to the possibility of any international agreement about the future of the West Bank, the fate of this area can no longer be left in suspension. Israel must now in-tensify her efforts to engage the Arab population indigenous to the
