

ARABS EXPELLED FROM WEST BANK

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Five prominent West Bank Arabs were expelled to Lebanon by the Israeli Army.

The action came after they were charged with incitement of the anti-Israel rioting that swept the West Bank and East Jerusalem during the past week. News of the expulsions set off several demonstrations and some rock throwing in West Bank towns. Security forces were alerted to the possibility of more serious incidents.

All five have been active in the so-called Palestine National Front, a political organization that has specialized in propa-

ganda since the Yom Kippur War, but until the recent unrest was not involved in violent acts. They were the second group of West Bank dignitaries expelled this month. The earlier group was sent to Lebanon, November 4, although in the past, troublemakers were usually deported to Jordan.

ISRAEL BARRED FROM EUROPEAN GROUPING

PARIS (WNS) -- The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, in its second anti-Israel action this week, voted to reject Israel's bid for membership in UNESCO's European regional group, one of five regional groupings

in the UNESCO structure.

Israel is not a member of the other four groupings.

The vote, engineered by the same Arab-Communist bloc which voted the previous day to condemn Israel and withhold UNESCO aid on the ground that Israel "persisted in altering the historical features" of Jerusalem by excavations, was 48 against Israel and 33 for, including the United States, Canada, 14 West European countries and 12 Latin American nations.

France was one of the 31 delegations which abstained.

LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE

DIRTY LIES ON JEWS IN FRENCH CITY

PARIS (WNS) -- A new "Orleans affair" has broken out in the French city of Chalon sur Saone where public rumors are being circulated that local Jews are "kidnapping" teen-aged girls and "selling them abroad."

Jewish sources in Chalon sur Saone said that the rumors started about two weeks ago in the local high school for girls. From there it spread to the rest of the city's population. Soon after the rumors first started, anti-Jewish slogans were painted at night on Jewish-owned shops.

Rumors, similar to those which rocked Orleans in the spring of 1969, claim that Jewish shop keepers drug and kidnap their non-Jewish customers, especially young girls, to sell them abroad. At the request of the local 200-member Jewish community the local police investigated the rumors and printed a denial in the city's newspaper, "Le Courrier." In spite of this, the rumors are continuing unabated.
