

ISRAEL TO DOUBLE POPULATION BY 1999

Israel's goals, for the next 25 years, is to double her Jewish population in Israel.

Israel will have available, in the very near future, 15,000 jobs, and at least half of them will be open to American professionals.

During the next 18 months, Israel will build 23,000 new housing units that will be available for new Olim (settlers).

Mr. Pinhas Sapir, Chairman of the Executive of the World Zionist Organization and the Jewish Agency, expressed these points when he met with the leadership of the American Jewish Community, Jewish Students and the Association of Americans and Cana-

dians for Aliyah. During these meetings, Mr. Sapir expressed the belief that the only place the future population can come from is the Diaspora, especially the United States.

Mr. Sapir also pointed out that Israel now needs new settlers more importantly than they need money or armaments during this time of stress.

At a meeting, soon to be held, between Israel and American Jewish leadership, Americans will now be asked to take on the responsibility of Aliyah to Israel, as they have in the past concerning money and moral support.

Mr. Sapir feels that settlement in Israel is more urgent than moral support if Israel is to continue to grow.

CONGRESSIONAL ASST. DENIES BIAS

WASHINGTON, D.C. (WNS) -- Thaddeus Garret, chief assistant to Rep. Shirley Chisholm (D. N.Y.) denied that he had made anti-Israel and anti-Semitic remarks attributed to him by a group of visiting Israeli lawyers.

The group said that Garret had "accused Israel of inhumane acts toward Arab refugees," and had complained that "only the Arab guerilla activities come up in (American) press and TV" because the media is "governed by Jews."

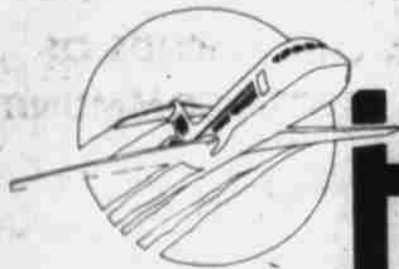
