a dinner in her honor by the Labor Friends of Israel which was attended by Prime Minister Harold Wilson, Cabinet members and some 100 Members of Parliament. Mrs. Meir told the Labor group that during the Yom Kippur War, President Richard Nixon "not known as a member of the Socialist International, sent us arms, while countries ruled by our socialist friends" did not cooperate.

"We abhor war but we also know how to defend ourselves," she declared. "We shall not volunteer to be sacrificed so that the rest of the world may live in peace."

Referring to the anti-Israeli and pro-Palestine Liberation Organization resolutions approved by the UN General Assembly, Mrs. Meir said "we are deeply disappointed with our friends -- from our enemies we expect nothing -- who abstained when the vote was about the destruction of Israel."

Addressing the gathering as "fellow friends of Israel," Prime Minister Wilson said that Resolution 242 of the Security Council is the cornerstone of Britain's Mideast policy.

ISRAEL WOULD OPEN USSR RELATIONS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel continues to be prepared to resume diplomatic relations with the Soviet Union, Foreign Minister Yigal Allon told the Knesset. "Our standpoint has always been and still is that despite differences of opinion between us and the Soviet Union, misunderstanding can be prevented, and even

a certain measure of mutual understanding achieved, through constant and direct contacts which are possible only between countries which maintain diplomatic relations," Allon said. He said the Soviet Union was aware of Israel's attitude but neither the USSR or any other Communist block country had approached Israel about resuming the diplomatic relations broken during the 1967 Six-Day War.

Allon said there were also no changes in the People's Republic of China's attitude toward Israel but the government will continue to seek contacts directly or indirectly with Peking.

MIDEAST DIFFERENCES NOT SETTLED BY FORD

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The United States and the Soviet Union have not changed their different views on the approach to be used to settle the Mideast conflict, President Ford told a White House press conference.

Ford said his talks with Soviet Communist Party Secretary Leonid I. Brezhnev at Vladivostok involved a discussion of "our position and their position, and, as we discussed it, I think we came to a higher degree of understanding in that our position was understood by them and the prospects of the Geneva agreement was understood by us."

The U.S. favors step-by-step bilateral talks between Israel and the Arab states while the USSR wants a resumption of the Geneva peace conference, of which it is co-sponsor with the U.S. Ford said there was no discussion of Israel agreeing to negotiate with the Palestine Liberation Organization in return for the PLO's recognition of Israel's right to exist. "Israel has indicated that it would not negotiate with the PLO," Ford said, adding "we have no way of forcing them to do so."
