

## JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- There is no chance of encouraging new Arab leadership in the West Bank as an alternative to the Palestine Liberation Organization's leadership of the Palestinians according to Yitzhak Navon, chairman of the Knesset Foreign Affairs and Security Committee and an expert on Arab affairs.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israeli troops were searching the beaches and hills along the northern coast for the surviving members of a terrorist gang who infiltrated Kibbutz Rosh Hanikra near the Lebanese border and wounded one of the Kibbutz members, Gil Livneh, who was standing in the doorway of his home.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The use of birth control pills is permissible, according to Ashkenazic Chief Rabbi Shlomo Goren, if the mother has fulfilled the halachic injunction to "be fruitful and multiply."

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israelis living abroad, especially those of military age who refuse to return for compulsory military duty, may face the loss of their passports under a crack-down planned by the Israeli Army.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Israeli army will continue to strengthen its lines in Sinai despite any diplomatic talks that may take place with Egypt, Chief of Staff Gen. Mordechai Gur said in an Army Radio broadcast.

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- UNESCO has been condemned for excluding Israel from its programs by the 100-member United States National Commission for UNESCO.

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- The B'nai B'rith Women Executive Board has voted to continue its sponsorship of the Arab-Jewish project, which sponsors teams of Arab and Jewish university students to conduct social service projects in Israel's Arab cities and villages, which was started by B'nai B'rith Women in 1967, after the Six-Day War.

HAIFA -- Dr. Daniel Revel, an internationally noted authority on Nuclear Physics, and for the past twenty years associated with the reactor of the French Atomic Energy Commission at Saclay, has been named first occupant of the Isaac Taylor Chair at the Technion - Israel Institute of Technology.

MONTREAL (WNS) -- Former Israeli Premier Golda Meir, speaking at three events at which more than \$2 million in Israel Bonds were sold here, cautioned against giving into pessimism about Israel's future. "As long as we in Israel maintain our spirits," she said, "as long as our Jewish friends all over the world refrain from complaining 'how long can this go on?' we shall overcome."

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The United States and the Soviet Union have agreed to an annual Jewish emigration of more than 35,000 but not the reported 60,000 figure or any other specific number, according to Pinhas Sapir, chairman of the Jewish Agency Executive.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The Defense Department has reportedly offered Israel 48 of the latest U.S. fighter planes, the McDonnell Douglas F-15 valued at over a half-billion dollars and Israel has accepted.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Liberty Lobby, a far-right propaganda apparatus, has said that the Mutual Broadcasting System will no longer make its five-minute daily show available to its 600 affiliates following the disclosure by the B'nai B'rith Anti-Defamation League that the program was used to peddle anti-Semitic propaganda.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The National Gallery of Art cancelled a press preview of an archaeological exhibit sponsored by the People's Republic of China because the Chinese refused to allow newsmen from Israel, Taiwan, South Korea and South Africa to attend.

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- The General Assembly's Legal Committee over Israel's objection, has decided to recommend to the Assembly that it postpone its scheduled debate on terrorism until next year.
