Moscow Ace Card In a Power Game

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- It now appears that Moscow's 'ace card' in its basic power game to achieve begemony in the vital strategic areas such as the Middle East and the Indian Ocean -- a 'card' used in its dealings with both the Arabs and the United States as well as with most Western European states as well community of three million Jews held as 'hostages' for a much higher price of 'ransom' than has now been offered by the newly-signed U.S. Trade Bill.

to which they have subscribed, namely, that "everyone has a right to leave his country and return thereto" without hindrance...

But the Soviets are not known to live up to treaty obligations. The world now knows that, despite detente, the Russians were the ones who created the situation that sparked the Six Day War and despite detente they played a Day War and, despite detente, they played a sinister role in the Yom Kippur War. To date the Kremlin leaders have shown no sign whatsoever that they can be trusted, and undoubtedly, Henry Kissinger is all too slowly beginning to learn this lesson.

So what do we see? We see the Arabs using their call to blackmail the Weer into doing

their 'oil' to blackmail the West into doing

their bidding versus Israel, and we see,
something far worse, the Soviets using human
lives, their Jewish citizens, fortrade and barter
on two fronts — a sort of auction procedure
during which the highest bidder gets his 'prize.' As it now appears, the Arabs are out-bidding the United States.

Over a year and a half ago your corres-pondent stated in this column that "some of the European leaders have come to recognize that military confrontations are not an imperative any more to 'destroy' a so-called 'enemy.' They hold this can be done through economic warand that is exactly what is happening today. Co-existence and detentes are well and good," we said, "only if there can be full trust on both sides. But, if detentes are undertaken with one of the parties entertaining ulterior motives then the other party is dutybound to take another look at the possible long-range out-

Fearing the worst, we went on to note that "America is today the victim of self-delusion as far as its relations with other nations are concerned, more particularly with the Soviet Union, France and even West Germany. The Soviet Union has been engaged in a diabolic scheme to win over to its side some of America's 'allies' -- foremost among them France and West Germany, in Europe, and Iran, in the Near East hinterland -- through the formulation of 'Friendship' treaties, not to speak of the great in-fluence Moscow wields in the oil-rich Arab world versus the United States."

That the greatest peril facing the United States today lies in the Russian-Arab maneuver to strangle America economically was brought out by George Topas of Lakewood, New Jersey, in a letter published by The N.Y. Times which stated, in part:

"The reality of the Soviet-Arab conspiracy to destroy the American economy as a positive force in the world order has become more apparent through recent Arabattempts to acquire interests in major American defense and defense-related industries. With huge profits piling up, the Arabs are now in a position to buy control of key United States industries which could undermine the integrity of American interests and even cripple our ability to defend ourselves ...

And so, once again in our times we see a movement rising on the world scene -- this time under Russian leadership -- aimed against the Jewish people reborn in their ancient homeland, and against the one nation on the globe, the United States of America, which has committed itself to defend Israel, come what may!
