

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

LONDON (WNS) -- Dr. Nahum Goldmann, president of the World Jewish Congress, believes that Israel's existence is not in danger, that there is no new holocaust around the corner and the world which had a bad conscience over the Holocaust no longer exists.

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- The International League for the Rights of Man charged the Government of Iraq with attacks against its Kurdish national minority with atrocities "on the scale approaching genocide."

NEW YORK (WUP) -- "The possibility of a shift to the Right on Israel's internal front has been sharpened by recent reports of a renewed activity within the governing Labor Party by supporters of former Defense Minister Moshe Dayan," according to Francis Ofner, correspondent for the Christian Science Monitor writing from Tel Aviv.

JERUSALEM (WUP) -- Economists from Rumania and Israel are currently studying the possibility of establishing joint industrial projects by the two countries.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Chase Manhattan Bank Chairman David Rockefeller told newsmen his bank had no plans to open a branch in Jerusalem.

LOS ANGELES (WNS) -- The American Friends of Tel Aviv University has been named the owner and beneficiary of a \$1 million life insurance policy purchased by Max Webb, of Beverly Hills, a prominent builder who has long been active in Jewish religious and organizational affairs in Greater Los Angeles.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Information Minister Aharon Yariv told the Knesset that despite continued international pressure on Syria there had been no significant improvement in the conditions of the Syrian Jewish community.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Yitzhak Rabin told the Cabinet that he rejected the view that the Soviet Union had cancelled the trade agreement with the United States because it was linked to Jewish emigration.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Former Premier Golda Meir was reported in good condition after a cataract was removed from her eye at Hadassah Medical Center.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israeli intelligence has reported that a Palestinian battalion of the Syrian army has established positions in southern Lebanon on the ridge opposite Har Dov, a strategic spur on the western slopes of Mt. Hermon overlooking "fatahland" which is occupied by Israeli forces.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Several hundred American Zionist Federation and Jewish Organizational leaders paid tribute to the memory of the late David Ben Gurion at an AZF-sponsored program.

Nimitz on Way Out

Israeli Ambassador Simcha Dinitz is expected to be recalled to Israel within the next few weeks. It was learned exclusively, early this month, that Dinitz will be asked to resign as Ambassador to the United States and return to Israel. No specific reason was given for the sudden decision.

The Ambassador was not available to confirm or deny the report, reliably learned by both Israeli and American officials.

A protege of Golda Meir, Dinitz, 45, succeeded Yitzhak Rabin to the Washington post in March, 1973.

Dinitz accompanied Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Yigal Allon on his visit to Washington last week. They met with President Gerald Ford for 80 minutes in the White House Oval Office.
