Dan Rowan and Dick Martin, return engagement in the Congo Room of Del Webb's Sahara, have been together nearly 24 years.

They've won laughs as a team 14 years longer than Dean Martin and Jerry Lewis and three years longer than Abbott and Costello.

It was 1952, when the late comedian Tommy Noonan introduced his friend Dan Rowan to his other friend Dick Martin with the suggestion that, "you two guys should get together."

Shortly thereafter, Dan and Dick began to collaborate on some ideas revolving around "tiny playlets", as opposed to the string of one-liners which were the forte of comedy

were the forte of comedy teams at that time. They did not specifically decide who would play "straightman", but Dan's excellent ability to set up a situation and Dick's off-beat reaction to it naturally evolved into their present stage identities. The rest is history! Mostly

small clubs in the beginning and one-night stands until the mid-fifties when they began to work as a supporting act to some of the leading vocalists

some of the leading vocanists of the day. In 1956, they were appearing in Miami Beach and were "discovered" by columnist Walter Winchell ho devoted volumes of space in his widely-read column to the brilliant new duo and literally lifted Rowan and Martin from obscurify to headline dates at important nightclubs throughout the United States and British Isles. In October of 1967, NBC

presented a one-hour special called "Rowan and Martin's Laugh-In" - smash hit that moved so fast the script for the single hour ran more pages than "Gone With the Wind". The show met with raves and became a weekly NBC series in January of 1968

That year the show won more "Emmys" than any other new show in the hirtory of television.
