Meanwhile there is a move within the Israeli

Cabinet by some ministers led by Defense Mini-Shimon Peres to move away from Kissinger's step-by-step approach and go into the full Geneva conference. They believe it would be unwise to make concessions now since a return to Geneva is inevitable. Likud Leader Menachem Beigin also seems to support a return to Geneva "if we say the right things there. He said Israeli negotiators must stress "our right to this land and our right under international law to withdraw from any cease-fire line without a full peace treaty."
