(Fifth term Assemblyman Zel Lowman, who served as Majority Floor Leader, is a member of Judiciary, Education and Health & Welfare committees. As President of Southern Nevada Drug Abuse Council, he is considered a hard-liner on law enforcement.)

The so called "bottle bill" was introduced this year for the second session. It is based on Oregon's statute which requires a deposit on all bottles and outlaws pull-tab cans for beverages sold in the state.

The Environment and Public Resources Committee received considerable heat on bill, A. B. 98, which would abolish all water rights within Nevada. The committee killed the measure.

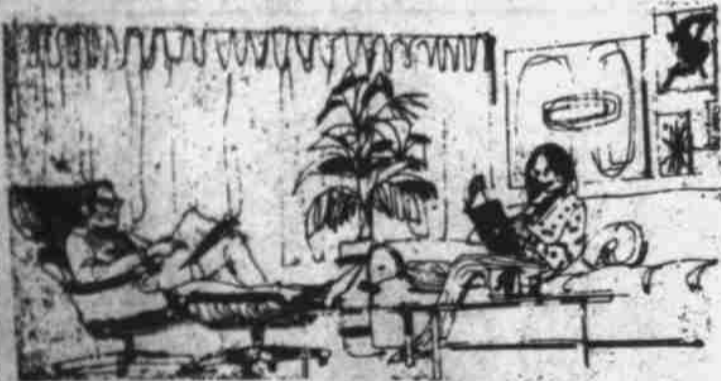
The Assembly Health and Welfare Committee heard a bill proposing to allow voluntary medical examinations and treatment for minors without parental consent. The measure had the support of the Nevada Medical Association, the League of Women Voters and the Planned Parenthood Association among others but was bitterly opposed by a member of the Knights of Columbus.

Scheduled for that Committee hearing were two measures, A.B. 17 and 51, both of which in varying degrees propose to restrain smokers from lighting up in public places.

Two measures were introduced to further extend the age of majority to allow gambling and the drinking of intoxicating liquor by those between 18 and 21, and a bill on lowering the penalty for possession of small amounts of marijuana have not been scheduled for hearing.

Clark County Legislative Delegation indicated that it will be necessary to repeal or at least postpone the division of Las Vegas into eight wards because the city elections are coming up so rapidly that the deadline for filing for mayor and city commission will apparently be past.
