

HADASSAH HOSP. TREATS ARABS

NEW YORK -- "Sickness knows no boycott," Rose E. Matzkin, national president of Hadassah said in response to the announcement that the Arab League Boycott Office in Damascus, Syria included Hadassah on its list.

"We shall continue to treat any patients who come to the Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center in Jerusalem," she said, "and that includes Arab patients not only from the West Bank, and the UNRWA camps but from other Arab countries as well."

"The Hebrew Physicians Oath says: You shall help the sick, base or honorable, stranger or alien or citizen because he is sick. That is our only standard Mrs. Matzkin said.

The Hadassah - Hebrew University Medical Center is the largest medical facility for healing, teaching and research in the entire Middle East. For years residents of the area have continued to come to Hadassah for its sophisticated diagnostic and treatment services such as dialysis, open-heart surgery, famed orthopedic, cancer and ophthalmological departments.

"Many Arabs seeking medical help come into Israel with special passes across the Allenby Bridge from Jordan," Mrs. Matzkin explained.

"Good medicine is based on humanitarian and scientific standards which we, at Hadassah,

believe have nothing to do with politics, and we shall adhere to these principles which are universally subscribed to by civilized people," Mrs. Matzkin concluded.
